Option Tour A: Saturday, Sep 18, 8:30 AM to 7:00 PM Los Alamos, Bandelier National Monument and Santa Fe @ \$86 per person.	Visit Bradbury Science Museum operated by Los Alamos National Laboratory father of the top secret Manhattan Project. Continue to Bandelier National Monuments to view the mesas, sheer-walled canyons and the ancestral Pueblo dwellings. Arrive in Santa Fe for a walking tour. (Minimum 20 people) Box lunch and beverages will be provided.
Option Tour B: Saturday, Sep 18, 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM Acoma "Sky City" Pueblo @ 75 per person	Acoma Pueblo, known as "Sky City", located in the spectacular West-Central Plateau of New Mexico. It is situated 350 feet above an outstretched valley atop a massive sandstone mesa at 7,000 feet above sea level. (Minimum 20 people) Box lunch and beverages will be provided. You could request a drop off at the Old Town for a late afternoon stroll.
